



COOKIE POLICY

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on the user's device when using websites or applications. They allow, among other things, to recognize the user's device, remember preferences, and ensure the proper functioning of the website.

2. Controller

Wellsi sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Kraków, ul. Praska 34b/68, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register under the number: 0001056762, Tax Identification Number (NIP): 6762650863, National Business Registry Number (REGON): 526321122, hereinafter referred to as "Wellsi" or the "Controller."

3. Legal basis

Cookies are used in accordance with the GDPR, the ePrivacy Directive, and the Telecommunications Law.

4. Types of Cookies Used by Wellsi

4.1 Essential (Technical) Cookies

These are necessary for the operation of the platform (including: logging in and maintaining sessions, security, remembering privacy settings, and protecting against abuse). Without them, the platform may not function properly.

4.2 Analytical Cookies

They help us understand how users use the platform. They are used for: usage statistics, improving features, and detecting errors. Used only with consent.

4.3 Marketing Cookies

They enable tailored marketing content. Used only with consent.

5. Special Rules for the Patient Panel

Due to the nature of the platform, only essential or analytical cookies with a low level of privacy intrusion are used in the patient panel. We do not use marketing cookies in the patient panel. This is an element of protecting user privacy.

6. Third-Party Cookies

Wellsi may use the services of external providers.

7. Storage period

Cookies can be:

Session cookies – deleted when the browser is closed

Persistent cookies – stored for a specified period or until deleted by the user

8. Managing cookies

User can:

- accept all cookies
- accept only selected cookies
- reject optional cookies
- change their decision at any time

You can manage your settings via the cookie banner or on the Privacy Policy page.

9. Withdrawal of Consent

You can withdraw your consent at any time. This does not affect the lawfulness of previous processing.

10. Policy Changes

The policy may be updated. The current version is published on the website.
